

Noida International Airport, set to open by April 17, 2025, will begin operations with approximately 30 flights on its first day, including three international and two cargo flights. The runway construction has been completed, and the process of acquiring a commercial flight license is underway. A trial run of the runway is scheduled from November 15 to December 15, with flights from airlines like Akasa and IndiGo being tested during this period. The data from these trials will be submitted to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation for approval, after which an aerodrome license will be issued.
