IndiGo will be the first airline to start flights from Noida International Airport, which is scheduled to be operational by the end of 2024.

In November, the country's largest carrier IndiGo had inked a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with NIA, becoming the airport's launch carrier

As per the Akasa Air-NIA agreement, which was inked at Wings India 2024 in Hyderabad, the airline will base aircraft at the new airport coming up in Jewar in Western Uttar Pradesh and operate domestic and international flights from there. Both the airline as well as the airport operator said that detailed contours of the partnership, including initial number of flights, would be finalised closer to the operationalisation of the airport.
